

## LWML Washington-Alaska District Invitation to the 2024 District Convention Sketch



## Cast:

Betty Battleship (personality is strong: she likes to call the shots) Angie Anchor (personality is calm: she keeps it all together) Peggy Perk and Johanna Java: baristas Supporting Singers

**Props:** A table with two chairs across from each other and angled toward the audience. Two coffee mugs are on the table. Another table is off to the side. *Optional:* aprons for the baristas and a coffee machine.

**Setting:** Betty and Angie are sitting down, having coffee at the table. Peggy and Johanna are behind the other table, pretending to make coffee drinks. They show interest in Betty and Angie's conversation.

**Betty** and **Angie** are having coffee and discuss how busy they are, how they are handling the needs of their families and friends, and all of the activities going on.

**Betty** shares how she often feels adrift in many aspects of her life even though she is organized and busy. **Angie** acknowledges Betty's comments.

Angie ends the back and forth with this: It's more than enough to sink one's boat!

**Betty:** (thoughtfully) I remember reading the 2024 district convention's scripture verse when I registered for the convention. It is from Ephesians 6:10, *Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might*. So, Angie, please keep me "anchored" in God's Word, be strong in the Lord, and focus on Him with JOY in all situations. You're coming to the district convention, aren't you?

Angie: Yes, I am!

## Peggy and Johanna approach Betty and Angie.

**Peggy OR Johanna:** We couldn't help but overhear your conversation. We want to know how we, too, can be "anchored" in the LOVE of God and be strong in the Lord.
