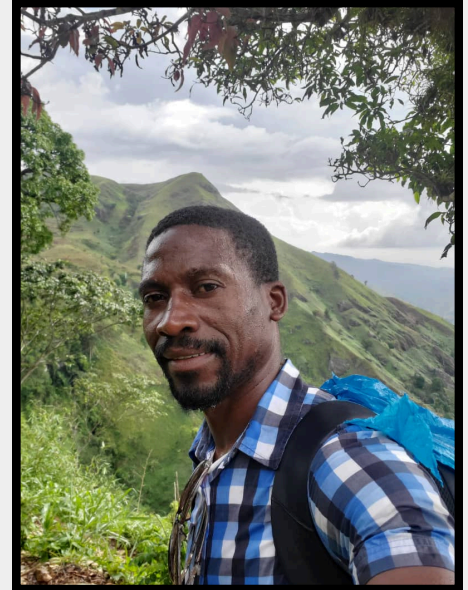

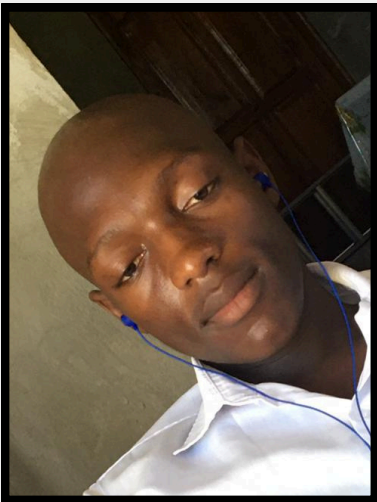
CHEDET, PASTOR IN PIQUET, ARTIBONITE

As a child Chedet attended Poteau, a school with a Trinity HOPE feeding program. The teachers at Poteau shared the love of Christ while Trinity HOPE provided a nutritious meal daily. When he wasn't in school, he held a Bible Club for children and adults in his community. He often asked God why he was on this earth wondering how he could best serve Him. Chedet remembered the Bible teaching he received at Poteau and felt led to the community of Piquet. Today he is a leader in this mountainous area and serves as their pastor.



GIVING BACK

Twenty-two-year-old Samson benefited from the Trinity HOPE feeding program for seven years. Now he teaches 5th grade at the same school, Merotte in Arcahaie. He became a teacher after his teachers recognized his abilities as a student. Perseverance helped him to learn English by practicing until he became fluent.
