When one of our Feeding Program Directors (FPD) shares a story, I am in awe of their courage, perseverance, and love for God. Recently, one of our FPDs sent me a picture of him crossing a river in a dugout canoe. Every month when he visits his schools to oversee the feeding program, he must cross this river. He is putting his life and livelihood in God’s hands. The Guayamouco River is one of the main tributaries of the Artibonite River.
